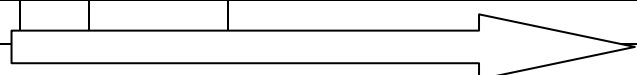

SEE OVER FOR RULES, EXPLANATIONS, and WAIVERS



**YOUTH** - person 18 years of age and under as of Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year  
**ADULT** - person 19 years of age and over as of Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year.  
**JACK BENNY**- adults 39 years or older as of Jan. 1st current year  
**NOVICE**- A person in their first or second year of showing, and who has never won a year-end high point award within our club. A novice may not have shown, judged, trained or assisted in training a horse for remuneration, either directly or indirectly, nor received compensation for instructing another person in riding, training, or showing a horse in competition. Any approved horse show judge is ineligible. Novices will remain so for the entire current year, regardless of point accumulation.

- 1) Western games require western attire.
- 2) All of the above classes will be offered per show but may be combined or cancelled at any time.
- 3) All exhibitors should be ready to enter the ring when their class is called.  
Classes will not be held up for competitors who are in another ring, nor will entry fee be refunded for the missed class.
- 4) Refunds : Entry fees will only be returned if the horse or rider are injured after arrival on the show site or if the class is cancelled by NRR Executive.
- 5) Excessive whipping, spurring or disciplining of horses will not be tolerated. Violators will be asked to leave the site.
- 6) Certified current helmets must be worn by all Youth in Speed Events and all jumping classes. Certified current helmets are acceptable in Western Performance classes.
- 7) Riders participating in Western Games are not eligible for Run What You Brung Events.
- 8) Riders participating in Run What You Brung are not eligible for Western Games.
- 9) For the safety and comfort of all, we require exhibitors and their parties to place all trash/debris in trash cans and **clean up their trailer sites of surplus hay and manure at the end of each event.**
- 10) A horse can only be entered one time per class with only one exhibitor. "A horse cannot compete against itself".
- 11) No Stallions shall be shown by exhibitors under the age of 19 years, including leadline.
- 12) Judge's decisions are final. Any discourtesy to a Judge or Show Official by an exhibitor, parent, or agent may cause the exhibitor to be dismissed from further competition in all events, no refunds.
- 13) No entering/exiting the ring at a run from any class.
- 14) Judges- A different judge will be selected by the Directors for each show. Judges will be selected from approved lists, ( i.e: W.H.A.O. Etc). Horses belonging to the judge or horses belonging to any member of his/her family shall not be eligible for entry in any class at that show.
- 15) The track at ODAS is off limits...no trailer parking, walking or racing of horses.
- 16) Speed events are electronically timed. In the event of timer failure, two stop watches will be used.

**Mystery Classes**- This class is designated as Fun Class and will be judged as such. (eg. Egg and Spoon, Steady Hand, Potato Race, Tandem Bareback,). The maximum speed in class will be trot/jog. The Judge will pull the class choice from "a hat "just prior to the class.  
**Class 16,20,22,40: Beginner Rider** Classes are open to new riders, or riders who ride only at the WTJ. Riders in these classes cannot compete in any other classes where the speed exceeds the trot/jog.  
**Class 44 Green Horse Over Rails** Class is open to green horses that are new to showing. Horses showing in this class cannot be entered into classes where the speed exceeds the trot/jog. This class is designed for the GREEN horse or one that needs experience-rider is eligible to ride other horses in other classes.  
**Jackpot**- in any event is not a point class. It is a money only class with no ribbons. Minimum of 3 horses. With 3-9 horses .payback to 3<sup>rd</sup> (1<sup>st</sup>50%,2<sup>nd</sup> 30%,3<sup>rd</sup>-20%) 10 + horses .payback to 5th(1<sup>st</sup> 40%,2<sup>nd</sup> 25%,3<sup>rd</sup>20%, 4<sup>th</sup> 10%,5<sup>th</sup> 5%)  
**Class 23 Pairs Pleasure**, tack optional class (Eng or Western) 2 horses working as one. Riding side by side, riders make be asked to hold ribbon .Class will be judged on how well matched the horses are in way of going, size, conformation, etc.

I also agree that if anyone makes any claims because of any injury to me (including death), or for any damage to my property, I will keep all those released by this agreement free of any damage or costs because of those claims.
